The primary goal of this program is to reduce victimization of senior citizens who are often targeted for specific crimes based on their age.

We know there are dishonest people out there who want to try to separate you from your money. We know there are two sides to every story, and we strive to be fair in all cases. There is no problem too large, or too small. Each case is handled on an individual basis, and confidentiality is maintained in accordance with Florida Public Record Laws.

Seniors Helping Seniors

You will be asked to gather all your documentation (i.e. receipts, work orders, contracts, etc.) and bring or mail them to our office so we can review your case. (Please supply COPIES only.)

A Senior Sleuth volunteer will be assigned to your case. Every attempt will be made to resolve your case to satisfaction through informal mediation. Successfully resolving your complaint will be our priority.

Not all cases may be resolved to a senior's satisfaction, but we do enjoy a very high success rate. Through our direct efforts, Seniors vs. Crime has recovered millions of dollars for seniors who had been victimized.

Any case determined to involve a criminal offense is turned over to the proper law enforcement agency for appropriate action. We will help you with that process also.
